Floral carving on Fruits and Vegetables European Championship


Since 2008, the Château d'Auvers welcomes the Artistic Carving on Fruits and Vegetables Championship. In 2010 it will become an International contest. This discipline, born in Southeast Asia, found many passionate persons in Europe and deserves to be highlighted.

We would like this championship to acquire its nobily letters in Auvers-sur-Oise, little French town which welcomed, during the 19th century, the most famous painters in the whole word.

This championship follows two principal characteristics :

- 1) « Artistic »
- 2) « Technical»

• You can compete for one or both of these categories.



Registration

Your registration form should be received before **April 5th 2010**.

To be sure to participate, please let us know your registration as soon as possible...

Registration fee : 10 euros (each person)

As soon as we receive your registration (joined to the payment), confirmation and full statutes will be sent to you;

For foreign competitors who are not in the Euro Zone, your form will not be registered until payment reception (10 Euros). At your arrival, you'll be given a swipe card in exchange for this payment.

ARTISTIC EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP



Your work should previously be created and set down to the « Château d'Auvers » :

- Friday, May 21st 2010 between 4 PM and 6 PM (*No refrigerator available on site*).

This work must be realised with carved flowers in fruits and/or vegetables.

Creation from 9.00 AM to 10.30 AM— In front of visitors and jury



Prize-giving on Saturday May 22nd 2010

PRIZES

All competitors will be valued on conditions fixed by our jury. Various nationalities will form this assembly.

- **1st, 2nd et 3rd** prize in each category (artistic and technical)

* *The first prize trophy should be thrown-in next year..*

- **Originality prize** will reward the most inventive work.

Floral carving on fruits and vegetables European Championship

« ARTISTIC »

Your work should previously be created and set down to the « Château d'Auvers » :

- Friday, May 21st 2010 between 4 PM and 6 PM (No refrigerator available on site).—
Deliberation of the Jury at 9.00 AM

Presentation

Your work should be displayed on the floor (Be carefull of vibrations when visitors walk on the polished floor) or on table (Maximum sizes : 2.5 m high x 2 m long x 2 m large).

This work will consist of assembled individual flowers and not carved flowers in a watermelon or a pumpkin.

* *If you need a table, please let us know.*

Realisation

Work made of carved flowers in fruits and vegetable. You may chose how many flowers and varieties you need. Flowers will be settled according to your creativity and, if possible, matching our main theme during Irisiades 2010 : Music...

* *This championship is about sculpted flowers and not instruments.*

Authorized in this concourse

Trunk, stump, wood, bark, water-willow, pottery's clay works, cardboard, plastic, glass... These supports have to be hidden by carved flowers and/or natural or carved foliage.

Natural and artificial moss (hidden by your creation).

Wooden pike and iron wire must be hidden by foliage or « floratap » (green, brown or white).

Vegetal glue has to be hidden too.

Only alimentary colouring agents are allowed.

Branches, stalks, buds and foliages are authorized without their flowers.


Woven can decorate your realization.

Forbidden in this competition

Seeds, spices, condiments, true flowers, paint, accessories as feathers, pearls, jewels, whims, paper ribbon ...

General Conditions

Your work must be accompanied with a text indicating the name of fruits and vegetables used as well as the number of carved flowers; Judgment will concern the carved flowers aesthetic quality and direction of the work.





European championship

« TECHNICAL »

On Saturday, May 22nd 2010

Realisation



1. Creation from 9.00 AM to 10.30 AM—In front of visitors and jury

Bunch of flowers

Realisation in 1 h 30.

This bouquet has to contain 9 flowers minimum.

The set subject flower is : Dahlia (without any colouring agent).

Creation in turnips (drawn lots by the jury and supplied by the organizing committee)

Your flowers must be settled on the provided support

Plan to bring your own wooden pikes.

The preliminary preparation of ornament leaves made of carved fruits or vegetables is not allowed (50 points penalty). Everything has to be made on the spot. (but for this, please bring your own fruits and vegetables).

2. Creation from 2.00 PM to 4.00 PM—In front of visitors and jury

Carving on entire piece

Realisation in 2 h..

Carving of a floral bouquet in a watermelon supplied by the organizing committee.

The addition of external flowers is forbidden.

This watermelon will be drawn lots by the jury.

3. Creation from 4.00 PM to 5.30 PM—In front of visitors and jury

The flower in all its conditions

Realisation in 1 h.

Duel by the drawing lots of vegetables or fruits by the jury.

List of the drawn lots fruits and vegetables. : Tomato, plum, garlic, fennel, hot pepper.

Make your flowers from what you will be attributed. Let your imagination act.

Only wooden pikes, synthetic moss and vase are authorized (supplied by the organizing committee)

4. Creation from 5.55 PM to 6.00 PM—In front of visitors and jury

The « Chrono Rose » in 5 minutes

A rose realization with 5 levels of petals as fast as possible (in raw beets).

General Conditions

The carving and cut equipment (including the cut board) must be brought by the candidate.

Flowers can be cut either with gouge or with knife.

No realization prepared in advance.




