**Competition and exhibition general conditions:**

- \* any citizen of the Czech Republic can participate in the competition
- \* even colleagues from abroad can participate
- \* it is necessary to bring parental written consent if you are under 15 on the day of the competition
- \* photographs taken by the organisers, showing the whole event and finished products, can be used in the press or for the competition further promotion without the participants' consent
- \* official photographs of the event can be used by other people only with the organisers' or co-organizers' consent
- \* Only the organiser and the competition professional supervisor has the right to make CD, DVD, a book or another print material for sale.

**Points range:**

- 1. Art processing** **30%**
  - \* overall first impression (top rated)
  - \* connection of the whole product
  - \* colour-matching
  - \* expression of the product's name
- 2. Degree of difficulty, the number of used techniques and motifs** **30%**
  - \* use of significant 2D or 3D motif (3D motif is better rated)
  - \* number of techniques
  - \* the number of used accessories (types) (suitable blooms, branches)
- 3. Originality, creativity** **20%**
  - \* an original dominant element is higher evaluated
- 4. Technical evaluation - work performance** **20%**
  - \* clean design (the finishing touch)
  - \* evenness of the cuts (by motifs)
  - \* *work gentleness*
  - \* *knife work (frequency of use of knife and chisel)*

**prizes:**

- \* participants are awarded according to achieved points:  
**a gold, a silver, a bronze medal or a participant's diploma**
- \* the top three in the overall placing will be awarded a Cup (Z/1 category-only the top rated team)

**committee:**

- \* the committee consists of carving leading experts

**NOTICE****The award ceremony**

- \* **all the participants must compulsorily wear their vocational clothes**  
**- chef - jacket and work trousers (not jeans) !!!**

**Exhibits removal**

- \* IT IS NOT ALLOWED to remove the exhibits before the end of the entire ceremony

## Individual categories propositions

<b>cat. Z/1</b>	<b>* a composition or a product prepared in advance</b>	
	theme - <b>Free Theme Composition</b>	teams (1-3 carvers)

assignment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <b>to carve a composition or a product out of vegetables or fruit (free theme)</b></li> <li>* <b>the exhibit must be named + it must be stated on which occasion it has been prepared for (it can be made-up)</b></li> </ul>
organiser:	ensures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* table Ø 120 cm</li> <li><b>NOTICE: The exhibit max. size: 90 x 90 cm, max. high: 150 cm</b></li> <li>* white tablecloth, number cards</li> </ul>
participants:	ensure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* table decoration (not rated), product description <b>without name and establishment</b></li> <li>* ingredients</li> </ul>
competition rules:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* a team can consist of 2, max. 3, participants, or a participant can also carve alone (<i>in the last mentioned case - the participant represents a team!</i>)</li> <li>* each team must be named (school or company name, etc....)</li> <li>* the composition or the competing product must be passed on to the committee for evaluation until 7.00am</li> <li>* compositions containing morally inappropriate motifs will be excluded from the competition</li> <li>* the final size depends on the author but it is necessary to meet the listed sizes</li> <li>* max. size 90 x 90cm, high 150 cm, min. size 35 x 35cm</li> <li>* larger sizes might be penalized points</li> <li>* all the exhibitors will ensure removal and transport of the exhibits</li> <li>* during the evaluation, each exhibitor must have the number card on his exhibit otherwise it can't be evaluated</li> </ul>

<b>cat. Z/2</b>	<b>* competition within the time limit - 3 hours</b>	
	out of fruit and vegetables	
	theme - <b>FLOWER COMPOSITION</b>	juniors + seniors

assignment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <b>to carve out a flower composition within the 3 hours time limit</b></li> <li>* <b>at least 13 blooms, maximum number is unlimited</b></li> <li>* <b>the composition must contain at least 2 types of bloom, of which one is carved out with a knife only</b></li> <li>* <b>you can use vegetables as well as fruit</b></li> </ul>
organiser:	ensures: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* table, chair and waste bin</li> </ul>
participants:	ensure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* ingredients, tools, chopping board, bowls and dishcloths</li> <li>* decoration for the final product (not rated)</li> <li>* you can use your own chair</li> </ul>
competition rules:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* it is necessary to meet the assignment, otherwise you can be penalized points</li> <li>* it is not allowed to add products carved in advance to your composition</li> <li>* you can use herbs and salads (beware of dried-up leaves)</li> <li>* the composition should be built as one whole</li> <li>* it is possible to arrange the products on vegetables or fruit stands (carved/not carved or inedible ones)</li> <li>* <b>NOTICE!</b></li> <li>* all the stands must be made of natural materials (permitted is for example - wood-trunk)!</li> <li>* you can't use sand, moss or stones</li> <li>* you can't use ceramic vessels, glass vases</li> <li>* it is possible to arrange on white porcelain plate (service plate) or dish</li> <li>* if you want to use carved stand, it also has to be carved out within the given time limit (it is not possible to prepare it in advance)</li> <li>* motor tools are not allowed</li> <li>* no ingredient can be prepared in advance before the competition starts (peeled, basic shapes prepared etc...)</li> <li>* only vegetables soaked in salt water are allowed (for example carrots - but not peeled)</li> <li>* all the ingredients and tools must be on the table during the competition</li> <li>* the jury starts and ends the competition</li> <li>* each competitor must place a card with his name and number on the table (you will receive this card before the competition)</li> <li>* each participant competes at own risk</li> <li>* the competitor must neither leave his competition table nor accept help from the accompanying person</li> <li>* <b>nothing can be under the table neither at the start nor during the competition (boxes, ingredients, tools), everything must be on the table</b></li> </ul>
